General Order Re: Distribution of Court Business

North Central District

Pursuant to the Authority set forth in Rule 10.603 of the California Rules of Court, and as authorized by resolution of the Los Angeles Superior court Executive Committee on March 12, 2012 acting pursuant to Local rule 1.7(a), it is hereby ordered as follows:

Change of Local Rule

Effective May 15, 2012, any Local Rule directing the filing of limited civil and small claims cases will be altered in order to equitable reapportion the business of the Court within the North Central District. On or after May 15, 2012 and until further order of the Court or amendment to the Local Rules, limited civil cases will be reapportioned pursuant to the description set forth below.

To the extent that any Local Rule is inconsistent with this General Order, That Local Rule is suspended.

Distribution of Court Business

Effective May 15, 2012, all limited civil and small claims cases that would otherwise be filed pursuant to Appendix 2.B of the Local Rules, shall be filed pursuant to the zip code changes listed as follows:

91011-91012	Glendale
91020-91021	Glendale
91406	Glendale
91201-91226	Glendale
91501-91526	Burbank (Civil and Unlawful Detainer)
91501-91526	Glendale (Small Claims only)

All existing limited civil cases with a calendar date on or after May 15, 2012, noticed for the Glendale Courthouse, Department NC 3, shall be re-distributed to Departments: NC A; NC B; NC D; and NC E. Existing dates on calendar will remain with notification to be given by the Clerk. As of the date of this order Department NC 3 may continue matters to the newly assigned Departments in the Glendale and Burbank Courthouses.

This General Order shall be posted on the Court's website.
