- 4. Mail a copy of Judge Schnegg's letter to the newly appointed/reappointed humane officer;
- 5. Mail notice of the court's order (without mailing the resolution) to the police department, the sheriff's department, the Department of the California Highway Patrol., the State Humane Association of California, the State Humane Association, and the Department of Justice.
