The App’s intuitive and award-winning interface is optimized for mobile devices. Co-parents use the app to set up and view possession schedules, share child-related information, send messages, and securely communicate with attorneys, guardians ad litem, and therapists. Co-parents may add family members such as step-parents and grandparents, as well as other third parties. The App is rated 4.7 out of 5.0 on the Apple App Store, by more than 10,000 verified users. Many family lawyers also use the App for secure and encrypted communications with their clients. The App securely maintains records, which may be used to show compliance with court orders. The App includes ipayou®, an integrated payment solution that enables users to send and receive payments. Users may categorize the payments to show compliance with temporary family court orders, or to document payments and reimbursements in preparation for divorce proceedings and the structure of the final decree.</p> <p>Pricing: AppClose is free and will remain free for all users. App users can currently use <i>ipayou</i> to send and receive payments with no charge. In the future, a charge of no more than \$2.50 per transaction may apply. At least 60 days’ notice will be provided prior to the start date for any transaction charges. If <i>ipayou</i> transaction charges are applied in the future, all users will continue to have complete free access to all other features within the App.</p>
