
2 10. Request to Continue Hearing Date for a Request for Order or Motion, and Order Thereon
3 (Family Law) form LASC FAM 218. The clerk is authorized to continue a family law
4 hearing once pursuant to a party's or parties' execution of the subject form, but only when
5 there have been no prior continuances of the hearing for any reason.

6 11. Noncompliance With Firearms and Ammunition Order, Or Warrant (DV-830).

7 12. Order to Show Cause and Affidavit for Contempt (FL-410).

10 the Standing Order# 2022-SJ-035-00, is effective immediately, and is to remain in effect until
11 otherwise ordered by the Family Law Supervising Judge and/or Presiding Judge.
