BLANKET ORDER RE: ACCESS
TO JUVENILE POLICE REPORTS
BY THE COVINA POLICE
DEPARTMENT YOUTH
ACCOUNTABILITY BOARD

Pursuant to a written request dated March 30, 2005, Chief Kim Raney of the Covina Police Department ("Petitioner") requests a blanket order for the purpose of allowing the Covina Police Department Youth Accountability Board ("YAB") to access juvenile police reports. The YAB program is a diversionary program to steer first-time juvenile offenders from the juvenile court system. The YAB will be comprised of community volunteers that are appointed by the Covina City Council. Juveniles involved in the voluntary program will be monitored for six months and will include community service, counseling, and monitoring of school attendance and performance.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, the Juvenile Court hereby issues the following order pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 827 and California Rules of Court, Rule 1423:

1. Where necessary for the operation of the program, Petitioner or his agent may access the juvenile police reports of youths involved in the YAB program and may share the reports with the YAB members.


2. All information received pursuant to this order shall be received in confidence for the limited purpose for which it was provided and shall not be further disseminated, except as expressly provided above.

3. If Petitioner requires access to other confidential juvenile information, Petitioner shall submit a separate petition to the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Court.

4. This order shall remain in effect until or unless it is revoked or otherwise amended on the motion of the Juvenile Court Presiding Judge or at the request of any interested parties.
