SPECIAL BLANKET ORDER  
RE: PUBLICATION OF  
PHOTOGRAPHS OF PARENTS  
ON MISSING CHILDREN  
FLYERS

In order to facilitate the return of children abducted by their parent while the children are under the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court and receiving services through the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS), Find the Children requests an order from the Juvenile Court to allow the use of photographs of the abducting parent on missing children flyers by Find the Children.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, the Juvenile Court hereby issues the following Order:

1. Find the Children is authorized to use the photographs of parents who have abducted their children in its missing children flyers for the sole purpose of finding the missing children. The photographs shall not be used for any other purpose.
2. No information regarding the abducted children's dependency matter may be publicly released for any purpose without further order of the Juvenile Court.
3. At least two court days prior to the release of the photograph of the parent, DCFS shall notify the appropriate parent's counsel by personal service or fax of its intention to


1 release the photograph. If the personal service or fax notice is provided prior to 12:00  
2 noon, the parent's counsel shall have until 4:30 p.m. the same day to file any written  
3 objection with the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Court. If the fax notice is provided  
4 after 12:00 noon, the parent's counsel shall have until 9:00 a.m. the following judicial  
5 court day to file any written objection with the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Court.  
6 The parent's counsel shall notice all parties in the dependency matter of the written  
7 objection, including the assigned DCFS social worker. If an objection is filed, DCFS is  
8 not to release the photograph of the parent until the Juvenile Court issues an order for its  
9 release.

11 4. Upon receiving the photograph from DCFS, Find the Children will confirm with the  
12 DCFS Child Abduction Unit that the photograph will be used on its flyers and/or on the  
13 Find the Children website.

14  
15 This order shall remain in effect until or unless it is revoked or otherwise amended on the  
16 motion of the Juvenile Court Presiding Judge or at the request of any interested parties.
