## **SUPERIOR COURT OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY: COVID-19 EMERGENCY ORDER**

The following proceedings are considered essential and/or emergency under the current emergency orders:

- **RESTRAINING ORDERS:**
  - Emergency Protective Orders
  - Temporary Restraining Orders (Civil and Family Law)
  - Restraining Order Hearings
  
- **CIVIL:**
  - Civil Ex Parte Proceedings
  
- **CRIMINAL:**
  - In-Custody Arraignments
  - Criminal Preliminary hearings
  - Bail review hearings under Penal Code section 1275
  - Parole and post-release community supervision revocation hearings
  
- **FAMILY LAW:**
  - Family Law Ex Parte Proceedings
  - Hague Convention Proceedings (international kidnapping)
  - Emergency Orders Relating to the Health and Safety of a Child
  
- **JUVENILE:**
  - Juvenile Delinquency Arraignment/Detention Hearings, Adjudication and Disposition
  - Juvenile Ex Parte Orders
  - Juvenile Restraining Orders
  - Juvenile Delinquency Detention Hearings and related case processing
  - Juvenile Dependency Detention Hearings and related case processing
  - Emergency Orders Relating to the Health and Safety of a Child

  - Expedited Petitions to Approve Compromise of Disputed Claim or Pending Action 6 or Disposition of Proceeds of Judgment for Minor or Person with a Disability 7 Pursuant to California Rule of Court 7.950.5, if no hearing is required

**Further, please note that the Court has continued all Unlawful Detainer (eviction) trials without a determination pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 1170.5(c).**
