


1 video sought, the specific reasons disclosure is warranted, why there are no other alternatives, proposals
2 for minimizing the potential impact on overriding interests, including maintaining the court's security,
3 litigants' rights to a fair trial, protection of minor victims and witnesses, privacy interests of jurors,
4 protection of witnesses from embarrassment or intimidation, protection of attorney-client privilege,
5 national security, and the maintenance of courtroom dignity and decorum. (NBC v. Superior Court
6 (1999) 20 Cal.4th 1178, 1222, n. 46.)

7 Upon receiving any subpoena or request for access to such video, the Sheriff or Clerk of the
8 Court shall provide the requestor with a copy of this Order, and notify the Supervising Judge of the
9 Criminal Division of the request and the delivery of a copy of this order. Unless further directed by the
10 court, no further action or court appearance by the Sheriff or Clerk of the Court is necessary.

11 Effective immediately, this General Order is to remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the
12 Presiding Judge.
