ORDER **APPOINTING** ATTORNEY FOR
CHILD PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA
RULES OF COURT, RULE 5.663 FOR
EDUCATION REPRESENTATION AND
WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE §§
202 AND 727; WAIVER OF
CONFIDENTIALITY FOR JUVENILE
COURT RECORDS PURSUANT TO
WELFARE & INSTITUTIONS CODE §§
827 AND 827.9 AND CALIFORNIA RULES
OF COURT, RULE 5.552; WAIVER OF
FEES FOR COPYING JUVENILE COURT
RECORDS PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA
RULES OF COURT, RULE 3.61

Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 5.663 (“Rule 5.663”) and Welfare and Institutions Code (“WIC”) §§ 202 and 727, and subject to the approval of the individual who holds the child's educational rights **[name and contact information of attorney]**, is appointed to represent **[minors name]** for the purpose of resolving the education issue(s) delineated in a Rule 5.663 Education Referral Form filed on **[date of 5.663 filing]**.

Pursuant to WIC sections 827 and 827.9, Penal Code section 11166.1, and California Rules of Court, Rule 5.552, the Los Angeles Court Probation Department (“Probation”) and the Juvenile Court shall

1 provide the above-named attorney with access to all of the child's juvenile court records. In addition, the
2 above-named attorney shall be given access to any juvenile court records within the meaning of these
3 sections and which are in the possession of any other agency or entity.
4

5 The above-named attorney may use the documents contained in the juvenile court record and
6 information relating to the content of the juvenile court record only for the purposes of investigating,
7 litigating or resolving the education issue(s). The juvenile court record and any information relating to
8 the content of the juvenile court record may not be used or disseminated for any purpose other than
9 investigating, litigating or resolving the education issue(s) without prior approval of the Juvenile Court
10 Presiding Judge or other judicial officer designated by the Juvenile Court Presiding Judge.
11

12 If the requested records from Probation are not provided within 14 days of the request or as otherwise
13 agreed to by the parties, the above-named attorney may notify the court in writing, specifying the dates
14 upon which such requests were made and denied and the reasons for the denial. The court may issue an
15 Order to Show Cause ("OSC") regarding why such records have not been produced. The party failing to
16 produce the records will have 14 days from the date that the OSC was issued to either produce the
17 records or appear before the court and explain why such documents have not been produced.
18

19 Pursuant to Rule 3.61 of the California Rules of Court, payment of fees for copying juvenile court
20 records is waived. Probation only shall be required to copy juvenile court records at no cost if such
21 records are not contained in the juvenile court file.
22

23 During the course of this appointment, the above-named attorney shall keep the child's Delinquency
24 Court and the Delinquency Court of record attorney informed of the results of his or her efforts.
25

1 When the above-named attorney has completed the task for which he or she was appointed, the attorney
2 shall file a written request with the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Court to be relieved, with notice to
3 the child's Delinquency Court attorney and the holder of the educational rights.

4
5 The above-named attorney is appointed on the condition that the attorney understands that he or she will
6 not receive, and may not seek, financial compensation for services from the Juvenile Court, caregiver,
7 parent/legal guardian, or individual who holds education rights. The above-named attorney may seek
8 attorney's fees from the school district and all other appropriate parties if such compensation is available
9 as a remedy.
