KENYON JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER DELINQUENCY CASE REASSIGNMENT

Effective April 1, 2013, all new non-detained juvenile delinquency petitions, previously filed and heard at the Kenyon Juvenile Justice Center, will be filed and heard as set forth in the attached table.

Effective May 1, 2013, all new detained juvenile delinquency petitions, previously filed and heard at the Kenyon Juvenile Justice Center, will be filed and heard as set forth in the attached table.

New Juvenile Delinquency Petitions:

Effective April 1, 2013, for non-detained petitions and May 1, 2013, for detained petitions, new cases previously intended for filing at the Kenyon Juvenile Justice Center will be filed and heard as reflected in the attached table.

Transfer of Existing Cases:

Beginning April 1, 2013, and pursuant to LASC Local Rule 2.3(b)(5), all existing juvenile delinquency cases filed at the Kenyon Juvenile Justice Center with continuance dates set after June 3, 2013, will be ordered reassigned to juvenile delinquency bench officers at the Los Padrinos Juvenile Courthouse, the Compton Courthouse, the Inglewood Juvenile Courthouse, the Eastlake Juvenile Courthouse, or the Long Beach Courthouse, depending on the citing law enforcement agency. Alternatively, cases may be reassigned in a manner that poses the least inconvenience to families and conforms to promoting the ends of justice. Individual transfer notices for each reassigned case will be delivered or sent to all interested parties.

SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF KENYON JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER

MEMO – Closure of Kenyon Juvenile Justice Center
March 5, 2013
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The Kenyon Juvenile Justice Center will close effective June 14, 2013, as part of the Court's contraction plan due to budget reductions. Departments 264 and 265, currently located at the Kenyon facility, will close and the currently assigned bench officers will be relocated to other juvenile delinquency facilities. Based on recent meetings with law enforcement and other justice partners, the attached notice serves to inform all interested parties where new cases will be filed in anticipation of the Kenyon Courthouse closure. The notice also serves as a guide to reflect where existing cases will be reassigned based on the upcoming closure of the Kenyon Courthouse. As reflected on the notice, all out of custody new filings will be cited to new locations beginning on April 1, 2013. Detained new filings will be filed in new locations effective May 1, 2013. Existing matters will be distributed by determination of the Court as they appear on calendar prior to the closure date of the facility, June 14, 2013. For all existing matters calendared at the Kenyon location following June 14, 2013, including matters with outstanding bench warrants, Court staff will send out notices of case reassignment to parties involved in those active cases based on Court Order and as set forth in the attached matrix.
