L.A. Superior Court Offers Free Surplus Furniture to Most Government Agencies

The Los Angeles Superior Court now offers surplus courtroom and office furnishings to many government agencies, including schools and other special districts.

Years of budget reductions that culminated in the closure of eight courthouses in 2013 have left the Los Angeles Superior Court (LASC) with surplus office furniture. Surplus property no longer needed by the Court for its own use can be donated to another government or public agency pursuant to California Rules of Court, Section 10.830(a)(3).

By linking to LASC's Surplus Property Donation Program URL, authorized agencies can order surplus furniture and furniture-related items that have been designated for donation, such as bookcases, chairs, credenzas, file cabinets, shelves, tables, and other miscellaneous items.

To access the donation catalogue, users are required to register to receive a user account. Users must provide information such as a Contact Name, Organization and Federal Tax ID in order to receive a user name and password to the Donation Catalogue. The agency that receives the order is responsible for picking up the items.
