LASC ANNOUNCES RELEASE OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS AIMED AT LEGAL SERVICE PROVIDERS

The Judicial Council of California (“JCC”) has released a Request for Proposals (RFP) #CFCC-2016-12LB, inviting legal services providers to apply for grants to operate pilot projects under the Sargent Shriver Civil Counsel Act. The RFP solicits grant proposals to provide services to unrepresented litigants in a number of areas including housing-related services and child custody matters.

The RFP includes the requirement that the Los Angeles Superior Court support the legal services provider’s proposal before the proposal will be considered by the JCC. LASC aims to provide guidance to legal services providers as to court priorities and needs that should be addressed in proposals to obtain the required court approval for the JCC to fully consider the proposal.

LASC has established a list of key elements that should be included in a proposal before it will be considered by the Court for partnership. Inclusion of these elements does not guarantee partnership, but no proposals will be considered for partnership by the Court unless the proposal contains these elements.
