## PRESIDING JUDGE KEVIN C. BRAZILE AMENDS 2020-GEN-023-00 GENERAL ORDER

On October 13, 2020, Presiding Judge Kevin C. Brazile issued an amendment to the General Order issued on October 9, 2020.

The amendment, which is attached, reads, "Paragraph 9 is deleted and replaced as follows: Family Law evidentiary proceedings, whether Family Code section 217 hearings or trials, other than restraining order hearings, that may be completed within five (5) court days may be held. Family Law evidentiary proceedings the total duration of which is expected to exceed five court days shall not commence before November 16, 2020, except as authorized by the Supervising Judge of Family Law."

AMENDED GENERAL ORDER 2020-GEN-023-01

On the same grounds, and for the same reasons as set forth in the General Order filed on October 9, 2020, the Court amends General Order 2020-GEN-023-00 as follows, nunc pro tunc.

Paragraph 9 is deleted and is replaced as follows:

Family Law evidentiary proceedings, whether Family Code section 217 hearings or trials, other than restraining order hearings, that may be completed within five (5) court days may be held. Family Law evidentiary proceedings the total duration of which is expected to exceed five court days shall not commence before November 16, 2020, except as authorized by the Supervising Judge of Family Law.
