Pursuant to the General Order of Presiding Judge Kevin C. Brazile, dated March 17, 2020, and in light of the closure of the Clerk’s Office effective March 23, 2020, the Clerk of Court is directed to reset the traffic infraction matters currently scheduled at any Courthouse as follows:

Traffic infraction matters currently scheduled for appearance at the Clerk’s Office any time between March 17, 2020 and April 16, 2020, are to be continued for 90 days. The March 17 through April 16 appearance dates are advanced and vacated. Defendants are ordered to appear in the Clerk’s Office on or before the continued dates.

Traffic infraction matters currently scheduled for Court Trial any time between March 17, 2020 and April 16, 2020, are to be continued to a new date as soon as possible after April 16, utilizing the Court’s matrix of witness availability. The March 17 through April 16 court dates are advanced and vacated. Defendants are ordered to appear on the continued dates.

**STANDING ORDER CONTINUING TRAFFIC INFRACTION MATTERS CALENDAR FOR
MARCH 23, 2020 THROUGH APRIL 16, 2020 IN THE CLERK’S OFFICE**

1 Traffic infraction matters currently scheduled for Arraignment or Court
2 Appearance/Court Hearing any time between March 17, 2020 and April 16, 2020, are to be
3 continued for at least 90 days, based upon courtroom availability. The March 17 through April
4 16 court dates are advanced and vacated. Defendants are ordered to appear on the continued
5 dates.

6 For defendants who have been released on bail, pursuant to Penal Code Section 1305.1,
7 the Court finds good cause to excuse the defendant from appearing March 17 through April 16,
8 2020. The bond is to stand pursuant to these findings.
