 PRESIDING JUDGE RE COVID-19
 PANDEMIC

GENERAL ORDER

In its continuing efforts to balance its obligation to maintain access to justice with its commitment to safeguard the well-being of court users in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic, the **SUPERIOR COURT OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Clerk's Office and Self-Help Center Appointments:

In the interest of safeguarding the well-being of court users, persons seeking services from the Clerk's Office, court support services, and/or the Self-Help Centers are encouraged to schedule appointments. For telephone or video assistance, or [to schedule an appointment](#), the telephone number for each courthouse is listed at the courthouse entry and posted on the Court's website, www.lacourt.org.

2. Face Coverings:

In accordance with [General Order 2021-GEN-023-00](#), all persons – regardless of vaccination status – are required to wear face coverings over their nose and mouth while in a courthouse. Persons whose disabilities preclude them from wearing face coverings compliant with the Guidance, are urged to seek an accommodation under [Rule 1.100](#) of the California Rules of Court in advance of their court appearance or appointment.

1 **3. Judicial Emergency Order Continuances:**

2 a. Juvenile Dependency

- 3 i. The Court extends the time periods provided in section 313 of the Welfare and
4 Institutions Code within which a minor taken into custody pending dependency
5 proceedings must be released from custody to not more than seven (7) days,
6 applicable only to minors for whom the statutory deadline would otherwise expire
7 from **December 4, 2021 to December 31, 2021**, inclusive.
- 8 ii. The Court extends the time periods provided in section 315 of the Welfare and
9 Institutions Code within which a minor taken into custody pending dependency
10 proceedings must be given a detention hearing to not more than seven (7) days,
11 applicable only to minors for whom the statutory deadline would otherwise expire
12 from **December 4, 2021 to December 31, 2021**, inclusive.

14 **THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT**
15 **UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, OR UNTIL ITS PROVISIONS EXPIRE BY THEIR TERMS,**
16 **ARE RESCINDED, AMENDED, OR ARE SUPERSEDED BY SUBSEQUENT ORDERS.**

17 **THIS ORDER MAY BE AMENDED AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.**


18 **GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, IT IS SO ORDERED.**
