



1 themselves to the courtroom bailiff, court liaison, or court clerk, and indicate they are  
2 carrying a weapon and the purpose of their visit.

3 **II. RESTRICTIONS ON PROHIBITED ITEMS.** All persons are prohibited from entering a  
4 Los Angeles County courthouse with any item listed on the Court's Prohibited Items list,  
5 attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

6 **III. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT DIRECTIONS.** While on or in the  
7 premises of any courthouse, all persons are ordered to comply with the lawful requests,  
8 directions, and orders of any law enforcement officers and their agents in the performance of  
9 their duties.

10 **IV. POSTING AND SERVICE OF ORDER.** This Order shall be posted at each public entrance  
11 to a courthouse; and at such other places that will reasonably provide notice of this Order to  
12 persons entering such courthouse. The Sheriff of Los Angeles County and his or her deputies  
13 and their agents are directed to serve a copy of this Order personally on any person who appears  
14 to be in violation thereof, to advise such person of the apparent violation, and, if the apparent  
15 violation continues after such notice, to immediately notify the Court's Office of Public Safety,  
16 Court Counsel, or Site Judge responsible for that courthouse, as may be available in that order,  
17 so that the Court can determine whether proceedings should be initiated to ensure compliance  
18 with this Order. This Order shall not preclude any law enforcement officer from taking  
19 appropriate steps to ensure the orderly and peaceable conduct of court business at a courthouse.

20 **V. PENALTIES.** Violation of this Order may result in the imposition of sanctions in amounts of  
21 up to \$1,500 per violation pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 177.5 and/or  
22 prosecution for criminal violations.

23 This General Order is to remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Presiding Judge.

24 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, IT IS SO ORDERED.

# PROHIBITED ITEMS

To ensure the safety of all who enter the courthouse, the following items are not permitted inside the building:



# NO

- Aerosol and flammable sprays (including mace and pepper spray)
- Alcohol
- Ammunition
- Animals (except service animals), insects and reptiles
- Belt buckles resembling or containing firearms and other weapons
- Bicycles, bicycle parts, rollerblades, skates, skateboards, and scooters
- Box cutters, razors, razor blades, and any bladed device or device with sharp edges or points
- Ceramic and glass containers
- Chains
- Cigarette lighters, gas lighters, matches, any device that emits a flame, and lighter fluid
- Firearms
- Flashlights (longer than 3" in length)
- Graffiti tools and large marking pens
- Handcuffs and handcuff keys
- Harmful biological and chemical materials
- Illegal narcotics and controlled substances, including marijuana
- Knitting and crochet needles
- Knives (including pocket knives)
- Laser pointers
- Locks
- Manicure sets, metal nail files, and nail clippers
- Martial arts equipment of any kind
- Metal hair picks and rat-tail combs
- Metal and studded belts
- Metal utensils (knives, forks, spoons)
- Replicas of firearms and weapons of any sort
- Rope (longer than 2" in length)
- Safety pins (larger than 2" in length)
- Scissors
- Sporting equipment
- Stun guns and tasers
- Swords and cane swords
- Tools
- Any weapon or item that can be used as a weapon (at the discretion of the Sheriff and Court Security personnel)
- Any mechanical or electronic smoking instrument which is capable of emitting smoke or vapor is prohibited and will be denied entry into any LASC facility. These items will not be held for safe keeping by Court or Sheriff personnel.
