Per the requirements of AB685, please note that each row represents one individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 and was on Court premises during the infectious period. A person with COVID-19 is considered to be infectious from two days before their symptoms first appeared until the time they are no longer required to self-isolate. A person with a positive COVID-19 test, but with no symptoms, is considered to be infectious from two days before their first positive test was taken until 10-days after the test was taken. Any individual who was not present AT THE WORK SITE during the infectious period or was off work DURING THE INFECTIOUS PERIOD is not listed.
